



What is the Breslov Research Institute?

Shortly before his passing in 1810, Rebbe Nachman told his followers that his influence would long endure. “My fire will burn until the Mashiach (Messiah) comes.” His words could not have been more prophetic. Generations of readers have been enthralled and inspired by his writings, which have been explored and interpreted by scholars around the world. In recent years especially, we have witnessed masses of searching Jews of all backgrounds – Secular, Religious, Zionistic, and Hasidic uniting in spiritual pursuit, seeking to understand and acquire the teachings of the Great Tzaddik.

However a common barrier prevents many from properly accessing these great works – *language*. Since its inception in 1979, BRI has been the main publishing house for translations of classic and contemporary Breslov books. More than 100 titles are currently in print, in English, Hebrew, Russian, Spanish, French, and even Korean. The Gates are now starting to slide open, may all who are spiritually thirsty, come and drink.

Why does BRI need your generous support?

Our deep, enduring love for this *mitzvah*, does not preclude the need for money. BRI employs a team of scholars who are thoroughly engaged in researching the texts and oral traditions of Breslov Chassidut, as well as producing scholarly and authentic works of the highest caliber. The consumer market is simply not large enough to offset the enormous costs of producing such great work. Much like all other private institutions and charitable foundations, we rely on public support.

A closing thought.

What kind of charity is eternal? Charity given to produce Torah literature for the benefit of others (Talmud, Ketuvot 50a). This applies especially to the writings of Rebbe Nachman, which teach people how to build their confidence and fulfill themselves. ***These books save lives!*** Why is such charity eternal? Once the book is printed, it is available for all. Each time someone reads or studies from it, the donor who supported it is rewarded. *The mitzvah even outlives him, providing a secure investment with guaranteed high yields!* In today’s market, who can guarantee that kind of an investment?

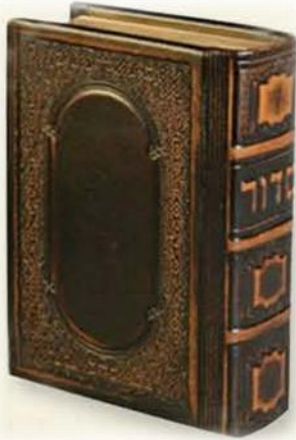


The Final Volume: Likutey Moharan Volume 15 Cost: \$60,000

The ongoing project of the translation and annotation of Rebbe Nachman's magnum opus. About 18 months for this volume. Work starting after Pesach.



The Breslov Chumash Cost: \$50,000 (Main sponsorship reserved) Short and Sweet, similar to Ma'ayana shel Torah (Wellsprings of Torah) Bereishis should be available in time for the new Torah reading cycle.



The Breslov Siddur – two volumes: Volume 1. The traditional siddur with translation and selected commentaries on the prayers. Volume 2. A running commentary on the siddur. Cost: \$40,000-45,000 It's structure, the order of the prayers and its deeper meaning, according to the Sages, the Kabbalah and Rebbe Nachman's teachings. It simply opens up ALL the avenues of what prayer is all about. To be written by Avrohom Sutton. This project will take about 2 years to complete.



The Breslov Kabbalah Series –multi-volume Cost: \$30,000 The teachings of the Kabbalah as explained in the writings of Rebbe Nachman and Reb Noson. These volumes are meant to bring the study of Kabbalah "down to earth," as they explain how these deep mysteries of Torah apply to each and every individual 24 hours a day seven days a week. To be written by Dovid Shapiro. It will take three years to complete this project.



Tehillim – Rebbe Nachman on Psalms Cost: \$40,000 The Book of Psalms with facing translation and insights from Rebbe Nachman and other Breslov commentators. To be written by Dovid Sears. May possible be a large beautiful coffee table book like the Breslov Pirkey Avot. Project to be completed by 2013.













The Fiftieth Gate, Volume Four Cost: \$14,000 The ongoing translation of the Likutey Tefilot (translated as “The Fiftieth Gate”). Reb Noson of Breslov’s prayers based on the teachings found in the Likutey Moharan. To date, we have three volumes (Prayers 1-20, 21-40, 41-66). This next collection will comprise Prayer 67 through Prayer 110.



