Beloved, ever-present G-d...this teaching strengthens me so much, because it means that there is no place that is far from You. Even if my thoughts, words and actions make me feel at such a distance from You at times, it is always in my ability to right now, exactly where I am, rediscover Your closeness.

And, when I do, I get to demonstrate Your greatness.

Thank You so much for sending a tzaddik like Rebbe Nachman to this world to remind me that You are only waiting for me to find You...no matter where I am.
