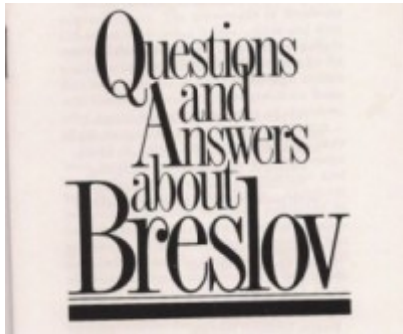


# How does one convert to Breslov Judaism?
