Revealing G-d's Glory

Rebbe Nachman of Breslov taught...

Every person must diminish his own honor and instead magnify the glory of G-d. When a person seeks his own honor, he does not merit to receive "G-dly glory," but only "the honor of kings," which others are always doubting and contesting. Seeking personal prestige results in others questioning his right to it, but when a person minimizes his own honor and seeks to magnify the glory of G-d, no one feels that he has leave to argue, because truly he has no right to do so. (Likutey Moharan I:6)

What does this mean to me?

One idea that I find very instructive in this lesson is that G-dly pursuits and selfless motives don't always together. If I find that as I seek to accomplish something positive, something "for G-d" in this world, I face the natural resistance of others, it's time for me to take a step back and examine the extent to which my own ego is involved in the project. If it's about me, I can expect others to come with legitimate questions of my motives. If it's really for G-d, I can rely that genuine disinterestedness will inspire other people to accept my work and appreciate it.

A prayer:

Please, G-d, help me diminish
And run away from my own honor.

Let me be concerned only
With increasing Your glory.

Even though I want to experience
A share of Your glory,
May I act for Your sake alone
And not for my own benefit.
