
The Importance of Stories About Tzaddikim

These illustrious Chassidim would frequently visit Medzeboz to pray at the Baal Shem Tov's grave, and in passing, most of them would visit Rebbe Nachman's parents. In this way, the Rebbe during his youth came to hear the many stories of tzaddikim that they would tell. These stories awakened in his soul the burning desire to serve God and to strive for the highest spiritual levels.
